For your convenience, parking is available right next to the castle. The site is secured by a barrier, ensuring your car is safe during your stay.


Upon arrival, please check in at reception for access and conditions. The entrance to the castle is just a short walk away.

Room Information



Please always lock your door when leaving and keep your key safe. Keys must be returned to reception upon check-out.

Rooms are cleaned daily. Staying more than one night? Towels placed on the floor will be replaced. Towels that are hung or folded will not be changed – helping us reduce waste.

All rooms have air conditioning. You can turn it on using the white panel on the wall and set your preferred temperature via the touchscreen. Heating is adjustable per radiator.

Not only because of its enchanting surroundings, but especially because of the people who have welcomed me with open arms. In Valkenburg, I feel at home.

Valkenburg is full of special spots that I love to rediscover time and again. The mysterious marl caves are one of the most fascinating places for me, with their hidden passageways and stories from the past. The cable car over the town also offers a stunning view, especially when the sun slowly sets. And for those who enjoy a unique experience, a visit to The International Butler Academy is highly recommended. Valkenburg never ceases to surprise and amaze, time and time again.

Step into a world full of mystery and history: the marl caves of Valkenburg are an absolute must-see during your visit to South Limburg. Discover how, more than 60 million years ago, layers of limestone were deposited on the seabed, creating a fascinating backdrop filled with small and large fossils. These extraordinary underground passage systems, carved into the soft marlstone, form an enchanting destination for young and old alike.


Let yourself be carried through narrow corridors and impressive halls where stories come to life. From the early Middle Ages to the dark days of the Second World War, these underground passages served as a refuge for those fleeing oppression, and even traces of German troops can still be found here. From ancient drawings and carvings in marl to surprising light shows and atmospheric events — there is always something to discover. In the winter months, the caves are transformed into a magical setting for one of the most unique Christmas markets in the Netherlands. What makes this place so special? The combination of natural beauty, cultural richness, and a touch of adventure. Thanks to the constant temperature of around 10 degrees Celsius, a visit is comfortable year-round — whether you're seeking coolness on a summer's day or festive cheer in winter.

The Cave Tour in the Roebroek Quarry in Valkenburg is one of the most enchanting and captivating experiences this historic town has to offer. Everyone is provided with their own audio tour, while a guide leads you along the route through the cave. Along the way, the guide shares fascinating insights in an engaging way and helps you navigate the passage system.

Looking for an unforgettable experience? Go underground and discover the mysterious heart of Valkenburg!

The caves are located about 2 kilometers from Castle Oost. This means you can be there within 10 minutes by car — super convenient! Of course, you can also choose to go by bike, which takes about the same time and lets you enjoy the beauty of Valkenburg along the way. And for the sporty ones among us, it's a pleasant half-hour walk!





Bike Rental

At the reception, you can rent bicycles to explore the surroundings at your own pace. Electric bikes are available for €30 per day and can be reserved in advance – ideal for comfortably discovering the hilly South Limburg region.

You can also visit the reception for maps, route descriptions, and personal tips. In addition, we are happy to inform you about current sights and events in the area, so you won't miss a thing during your stay.

Around Castle Oost, you'll find beautiful cycling routes, such as:

Castles near Valkenburg – about 20 km past Castle Oost, Castle Schaloen, and Castle Genhoes; a lovely short ride full of culture and history.

Valkenburg aan de Geul Castle Route – nearly 50 km through rolling hills, past several castles and estates; perfect for combining nature and history.

Marlstone Tour around Valkenburg – 63 km through picturesque villages, ruins, and the stunning Geul Valley; a challenging and varied ride.

Valkenburg – Gulpen – Eys – about 35 km along quiet country roads with beautiful views and opportunities to stop at local breweries.

Along the way, there are plenty of places to pause, such as Geulpark Valkenburg with its winding paths and the baroque castle garden, or the Sint Jansbos and Biebosch forests, where you can enjoy peace and nature.

Cycling is the perfect way to discover the charm of Valkenburg and its surroundings – at your own pace and with endless opportunities for delightful stops!



Fire Safety Instructions



Your safety is our highest priority. In the event of a fire, always follow the fire alarm signals and the instructions of our staff.

Fire extinguishers and emergency exits are clearly marked throughout the building. We recommend that upon arrival you take a moment to locate the nearest emergency exit, so that in case of an emergency you know exactly where to go.

Should an evacuation be necessary, never use the elevator — always use the stairs.

Evacuation



On the inside of your room door, you will find a clear map of the hotel's escape routes. This map shows the quickest and safest way out from your room. We recommend taking a moment to look at this route and keep it in mind during your stay.

In case of an emergency, it is important to remain calm, follow the instructions of the staff, and use the indicated escape route. This way, you can leave the building safely.



First Aid



An accident can always happen, no matter how small. That's why a complete first aid kit is available for guests at the reception.

For minor injuries, such as a cut or scrape, you can come here. If necessary, our staff will assist with basic first aid or refer you to the appropriate medical care.

Don't hesitate to contact the reception. We are available day and night to support you.

Medical Care



If you require medical assistance during your stay, there is always a doctor and a pharmacy near Castle Oost.

The reception has up-to-date addresses, phone numbers, and opening hours of these healthcare providers and will gladly assist you in making an appointment or arranging transportation if needed.

This way, you can be sure that you will receive prompt and proper care whenever necessary.




Quiet Hours

Pets




Pets are welcome with us, but on a limited basis and always by prior arrangement. This way, we ensure that both guests and animals feel comfortable during their stay.


If you wish, we will be happy to assist you with booking a taxi or planning your journey.
